The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.119 dated 01.07.2020 under Sections 419 and 420 IPC and Sections 66 and 66 d of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 registered at Police Station Cyber Crime Police Station, Gurugram, District Gurugram on the basis of compromise dated 18.10.2021 (Annexurte P-2).

As per the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram dated 13.04.2023, the statement of the accused has not been recorded despite two opportunities.

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In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition, if and when, the petitioner returns to India.

Accordingly, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
