The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry and take appropriate action against the private respondents in FIR No.0162 dated 07.10.2019 under Sections 302, 120-B and 201 of the IPC registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, has apprised this Court that after investigation of the case, challan stands presented against respondent No.4 whereas other private respondents were found innocent by the investigating agency as a result of which they were placed in column No.2.

Case has been called, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In the instant petition, a prayer had been made for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry in the FIR in question, however, since now the trial is underway, no further order is required to be passed in the instant petition which is disposed of accordingly.
