The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.173 dated 13.6.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 120-B and 506 IPC (subsequently added sections 201, 307 and 326 IPC and deleted Section 120-B IPC) at Police Station, Ganaur, District Sonipat.

By virtue of the order dated 16.1.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 16.1.2023 petitioners have joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Satbir has endorsed the fact that petitioners have joined investigation and submitted that they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 16.1.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
