1. Reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that under the interim orders of the Court dated 28.01.2022, the petitioner has already participated in the selection process and as per the provisional result, the petitioner has not been able to secure the marks equivalent to the last selected candidate in the category in which the petitioner was competing.

3. As per the respondents, the last candidate in the category in which the petitioner is competing, has secured 64 marks whereas the petitioner has only been able to secure 45 marks.

4. Keeping in view the above, especially than no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to press the present writ petition, the present writ

petition is disposed of with the observation that no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition as issue raised in the present case has already been rendered academic in view of the fact that the petitioner has not been able to secure the marks equivalent to the last selected candidate in the category in which he was competing.
