The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 61 dated 27.04.2017, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the interim order dated 23.01.2023, the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court and has complied with the said order.

The learned State counsel also submits that in compliance of the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the learned trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 23.01.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
