DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

(1) Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2020 registered under Sections 396, 302, 307 IPC (Sections 396 and 302 IPC deleted and Sections 412, 460, 216A, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 added later on) at Police Station Rampura, District Rewari.

(2) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since 26 out of 36 prosecution witnesses have already been examined in the petitioner's trial, he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to dispose of the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

(3) Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

(4) After considering the fact that 26 out of 36 prosecution witnesses have already been examined in the petitioner's trial; the petitioner is in custody for the last over 03 years and 04 months; every under-trial has a right to a speedy trial and that the State has no objection if the alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within five months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
