The prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.163 dated 18.04.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 452, 307, 212, 216 IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner is in custody since 11.06.2016 and only 18 witnesses out of the 54 witnesses have been examined so far. It is also to be noticed that the petitioner is an accused in 10 other cases.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial no later than 01 years from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
