1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of an FIR No. 176 dated 26.10.2017 under Section 67 of Information Technology Act,2000 and 500, 501 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Umesh Kumar submits that in the present case, after detailed investigation a final report under Section 173 Cr.PC had already been presented in the present case. He further contends that in the present case, five prosecution witnesses have already been examined out of total 08 witnesses and the trial is at an advance stage.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed off.

4. Needless to say that the petitioner shall be at liberty to raise all the

pleas available to her in the present case before the Trial Court, at an appropriate stage.
