This is a petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 13.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar, whereby the application filed under Order 6 Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure by the appellants/defendants has been dismissed.

A perusal of the file shows that vide order dated 23.10.2019, learned counsel for the petitioners was granted last opportunity to argue the matter, subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs. Although, the costs was deposited, however, again the case was not argued and vide order dated 20.01.2020, the matter was ordered to be shown in the urgent list. Once again, the case was adjourned vide order dated 22.01.2020. Not only that, earlier also, on several dates, the case has been adjourned on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioners. It appears that the learned counsel for the petitioners is not interested in arguing the present case.

Dismissed as not pressed.
