The petitioners through instant petition under Section 482
Cr.P.C. are seeking directions to official respondents to conduct fair and
unbiased investigation in FIR No.003 dated 01.01.2022 (Annexure P-1)
under Sections 323, 34, 354 & 506 of IPC (Section 379-A & 365 IPC
added later) registered at Police Station City Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* contends that
petitioner is author of the aforesaid FIR and petitioner has compromised
the matter with the accused who has filed CRM-M-47756-2022 seeking
quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise

This Court vide order dated 17.10.2022 has dismissed the aforesaid petition as withdrawn with liberty to avail alternative remedies. The petitioners time and again had appeared before Investigating Officer to tender their statements, however, Investigation Officer is not recording their statement.

Notice of motion

Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and assures the Court that Investigating Officer would look into the matter and record the statements of the petitioners.

In view of statement of learned State counsel, this Court is sanguine of the fact that Investigating Officer would proceed in accordance with law and do the needful. No further order is warranted.
