The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.03 dated 02.01.2022 registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (to which Section 27-A of the NDPS Act was added later on) at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 21.01.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.01.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
