ALOK JAIN, J. :

The instant petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for taking action on the complaint made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 04.01.2023 (Annexure P-5), to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T.Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the U.T.Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Satish Nain, has stated that the entire complaint smells male fide on the ground that the matter was already settled between the parties way back on 12.08.2022, which was signed by the petitioner herself. Apparently, there was no occasion for the petitioner to visit the said house and the petitioner has not taken any steps whatsoever even after 12.08.2022 to resolve the matter in dispute.

Without going into the merits of the case, with regard to the compromise or its effect, the petition stands disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T.Chandigarh to decide the representation dated 04.01.2023 (Annexure P5), moved by the petitioner, without being prejudiced by the present order, and in accordance with law.

In view of the disposal of the petition, all the pending misc.application also stand disposed of.
