Custody certificate is placed on record revealing that petitioner is in custody for 1 month and 24 days.

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.64, dated 10.04.2022, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC.

The only role attributed to the petitioner is that the assailants had come out of his house and that the complainant party was assaulted at the behest of the petitioner.

There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner was present at the time of occurrence.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the role attributed to the petitioner, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned.
