Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if the representation/request dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner for transfer of booth No.135-F, Bhao Randhir Singh Nagar, Ludhiana, be considered and decided by the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Ludhiana – respondent No.4 within some specified time.

In the light of the statement of the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon by directing the Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Ludhiana – respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation/request dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be granted to him within a further period of four weeks on completion of requisite formalities.
