AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 28.04.2019 declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person in FIR No. 96 dated 30.12.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the direction passed by this Court vide order dated 24.03.2022, the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court on 29.03.2022 and furnished his bail bonds on 31.03.2022, whereafter, he has been regularly appearing before the trial Court and is also ready to give his undertaking that he shall continue to appear.
3. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant affirm the factum of the petitioner having surrendered.
4. In view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
5. The petitioner shall, however, furnish an undertaking within 10 days by way of affidavit before the trial Court that he will continue to appear in the said proceedings.
