Both the above detailed petitions are being taken up
together for disposal by way of this common order.

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.121 dated
03.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC
registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh along with all
consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record certified copy of the certificate dated 10.04.2023 issued by the Punjab National Bank, wherein it stands reflected that the borrower/petitioners have made full and final payment of ₹ 115.00 lakh as per the terms and conditions arrived at pursuant to the One Time Settlement.

The said fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who, on instructions from SI Satinder Kumar, Police Station Economic Offences Wing, Chandigarh, submits that the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners have been duly verified by the police and the matter indeed stands settled between the parties. In support, learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to para No.3 of the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1, which has been placed on record today in the Court.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, the petitions are allowed and the FIR (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed. However, the respondent Bank shall be at liberty to approach this Court in case the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners are not found to be correct.
