Petitioner has been summoned to face prosecution in criminal complaint bearing NACT No.847/2019, titled as “*Sunit Bansal vs R G Residencey Pvt. Ltd. etc.*” pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Panchkula, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

The petitioner has not appeared so far. However, warrants of arrest against him has been issued, vide order dated 07.01.2023. This petition is filed for challenge the said warrants of arrest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Trial Court and seek regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court on or before 15.02.2023, the date already fixed there and move necessary application for bail. On his such appearance, the Trial Court shall consider the bail petition on the same date. If in the meantime, the petitioner is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner does not make compliance of this order, the protection granted to him shall stand vacated.
