The prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the convict/petitioner in light of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme court in **State of Haryana Vs. Jagdish 2010(3) J.T. 341** as the petitioner's sentence stands completed as per Policy dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-1).

The main case is already pending for 11.04.2022.

Today an application bearing **CRM-W-390-2023** is listed for disposing of the petition and to release the petitioner on interim bail in view of the order passed by this Court in COCP No.2020 of 2022 titled as **Pawan Kumar Vs. D.K. Tiwari & Anr** Decided on **30.01.2023 (Annexure A-1)** as the petitioner has completed the sentence as per policy available at the time of conviction.

On the oral request of the learned Counsel for the petitioner, the main case is preponed from 11.04.2022 to today and is taken up for hearing.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in light of the directions passed by this Court in COCP No.2020 of 2022 (Annexure A-1) titled as Pawan Kuamr Vs. D.K. Tiwari & Anr. the respondents consider the case of the petitioner for grant of premature release.

In view of the submissions made, the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for the grant of premature release in light of the directions passed in COCP No.2020 of 2022 within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
