The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to investigate the case bearing FIR No. 168 dated 24.11.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 34, 341 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Alewa, District Jind in a lawful manner after collecting all documentary, medical, oral and other relevant evidence including effecting the arrest of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dalip Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Uchana, on behalf of the State has been taken on record.

Learned State counsel contends that during the course of investigation, the arrest of four persons namely Jitender, Lakhan, Sunil @ Bira and Ramesh was effected and challan qua them has been presented in the Court. Furthermore, the charge has been framed and the case in the trial Court is at the stage of recording prosecution evidence. Respondent Nos. 4

and 5 were found innocent during the course of investigation.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail the remedies available in accordance with law before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
