Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0147 dated 24.3.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

2. On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed by this Court whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation.

3. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the aforesaid order of interim bail. He further submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as at the relevant time, when the alleged online fraud is stated to be committed, the petitioner was lodged in District Jail, Tonk, Rajasthan. 4. State counsel on instructions from ASI Shambhu Lal submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 18.1.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
