It is submitted that cross-examination of PW-4 & PW-5 on behalf of accused-Harsh Kumar could not be done on 6.1.2023 as the counsel was in some personal difficulty post-lunch. He was willing to cross-examine the said witnesses in the pre-lunch session. Thus, one opportunity may be granted to cross-examine PW-4 & PW-5 on behalf of the petitioner-accused.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no response is necessary.
