JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 18.01.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 30.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Judge Special Court, Amritsar whereby the bail order of the petitioner in FIR No.92 dated 10.11.2017 under Section 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural, has been cancelled.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for certain reasons, the petitioner was unable to appear before the Trial Court on a number of occasions despite having been granted bail on 14.12.2017. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Sewa Bharti Chandigarh, Sewa Bhavan, Sector 29-A, (Adjoining, 1 Sai Baba Rd.

Ordinance Cable Factory) Colony, Sector 29-B, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

In pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has not appeared before the concerned Court to join proceedings.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition, therefore, the same is dismissed.
