The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been invoked for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 230, dated 05.09.2022, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station 17/18, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated on the allegation that he has taken a bribe of ₹1,70,000/- for providing a job of Sweeper in Municipal Corporation, Gurugram.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed by learned State

counsel are taken on record. According to custody certificate the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of 2 months and 18 days and he is not involved in any another case of any nature whatsoever.

It is contended by learned State counsel that the transaction of ₹20,000/- has been shown in the account of the petitioner but the said fact has been controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner stating that the account in which the amount is stated to be deposited belongs to a lady namely Satinder Kaur.

Considering the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case and the custody period undergone by the petitioner so far, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands allowed in view of the afore-said terms.
