1. Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family as she apprehends danger at the instance of respondents No. 3 and 4.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Jitender Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters Jind, District Jind has been placed on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that at the instance of daughter of the petitioner, an FIR No. 183 dated 08.12.2021 under Section 506 IPC, Sections 12 and 14 of the POCSO Act and Section 67(B) of the Information and Technology Act was registered at Police Station Women, Jind. The matter was investigated and arrest of respondent No.3 was effected. On conclusion of investigation, report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has been presented against respondent No.3 for having committed the offence under Sections 506, 354-A IPC, Sections 12 and 14 of the POCSO Act and Section 67-B of the Information and Technology Act. Furthermore, at present, there is no apprehension of danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner and

her family members. The protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members shall be provided, if any complaint or information is received by the police and appropriate action, if any required, shall be taken, in accordance with law.

- 4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
