Petitioners have approached this Court praying for quashing of cross-case bearing GD No.5 dated 09.10.2019, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, P.S. Amargarh, District Sangrur in FIR No.164 dated 09.10.2019, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at P.S. Amargarh, District Sangrur along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Mahipal S. Yadav, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dhanvinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioners so far have not joined the investigation and hence, the matter is under investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioners to avail

their remedies as available under the law.

Allowed to do so.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with liberty as prayed for. The State is directed to complete investigation within a period of four weeks from today keeping in view the factum that the parties have already settled the dispute amicably.
