Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In criminal complaint bearing No.NACT-42-2020, titled as ***“Hardev Singh vs Sukhdev Singh”***, which was pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa, petitioner was declared proclaimed person and on the direction of the Court, FIR No.0319, dated 01.11.2022, under Section 174-A IPC, has been registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa. Apprehending the arrest in the said FIR under Section 174-A IPC, petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

It is contended by learned counsel that the petitioner was not served even once; that he is ready to surrender in the complaint case and join the investigation in the present case.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 13.02.2023. Learned Trial Court shall revive the proceedings of the complaint case and shall

consider the bail petition moved if any on the same date. At the same time, petitioner shall join the investigation in the present FIR under Section 174-A IPC and co-operate in the same. If in the meantime, the petitioner is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer. In case, the petitioner fails to make compliance of any of these directions, this order shall be deemed to be vacated.
