AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.1-Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, to consider and grant the rebate of 10% instead of 5% and refund the excess amount of Rs. 17,31,375/- as only rebate of 5% has been granted to the petitioner and that too for no fault of his. The details with regard to the facts are mentioned, according to the petitioner, in his representation dated 31.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) which has been submitted to the Estate Manager, Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, Panchkula.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Managing Director-Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation,

Panchkula to consider and decide his representation dated 31.10.2022 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would file a supplementary representation within a period of one week along with certain documents in support of his claim which may also be considered and decision taken by the Managing Director of Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition by directing the Managing Director of Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 31.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) and supplementary representation, if filed by the petitioner, within a period of four weeks. In case of the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential refund of amount of rebate of remaining 5% be granted/released to the petitioner within a further period of six weeks.
