Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 27.11.2018, while allowing the writ petition, the impugned order dated 17.10.2016 was set aside and respondent No. 3 was directed to send the case of the petitioner for induction/inclusion in the selection list of IPS Cadre for the year 1996-97 till 2006-07 within a period of three months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in the reply, filed on behalf of respondent No. 2-UPSC, it is stated in paragraph No. 7 that the proposal was examined and the deficiencies observed were intimated to the Government of Punjab, vide letter dated 26.08.2021, and some reminders were also sent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of communication dated 11.04.2023, sent by Under Secretary (AIS), UPSC to the Chief Secretary, Government of Punjab, wherein it is informed that

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the meeting of Review Selection Committee will be held on 27.04.2023 at 11:15 A.M.

Learned State counsel submits that the entire record of the petitioner, after removing the deficiencies, will be submitted (if earlier not submitted) on 20.04.2023 to UPSC.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, with liberty to petitioner to revive the same, if so required.

Rule stands discharged.
