MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.0167 dated 16.11.2013 (P-1), under Sections 420 & 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, including judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 19.07.2018 (P-2), on the basis of compromise dated 09.12.2019 (P-3) arrived at between the parties at their own level.

Concededly, an appeal against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence is pending before learned Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition.

Faced with the above situation, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all their pleas before learned 1st Appellate Court at appropriate stage.

Ordered accordingly.

However, it is observed that factum of compromise entered into between the parties be taken into consideration by the learned Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur while deciding the appeal.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
