At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that during the pendency of the present petition the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed by the respondent-Union of India and has submitted that so far as one of the grievances pertaining to revision of the disability pension is concerned, he may be permitted to file a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 and direction may be issued that in case a representation is filed, then the same may be addressed to by the appropriate authority.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of. Liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case any such grievance as aforesaid or any grievance is left out, then he may file a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 and in case any such representation is filed, then respondent No.2

shall consider and dispose of the same strictly in accordance with law within four months of receipt of such a representation.
