The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to enforce, protect and safeguard the fundamental rights to life enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India of the petitioners which includes right to peaceful life and eviction of the respondents No.3 and 4 from the self-acquired House No.467, golden Avenue, Phaze II, Garha, Jalandhar of the petitioners.

After arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the efficacious remedies available to them in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforementioned.
