Present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2-Malkit Singh, by learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, vide order dated 06.01.2023 in Case FIR No.81 dated 13.10.2022(P-1), registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 427, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'), at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala (Punjab).

(2) Concededly, the petitioner has already taken recourse to the remedy before learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala for cancellation of bail of respondent No.2 and the matter is stated to be pending for 22.12.2023.
