This is an application seeking grant of exemption from filing certified and typed copy of annexures.

Application is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

**CRR(F)-89-2023 (O&M)**

This revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 04.11.2022 passed by the Family Court, Ludhiana, whereby ad-interim maintenance to the tune of ₹10,000 per month was awarded to the respondent/wife from the date of the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. filed by her.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the petitioner/husband in his reply before the Family Court has stated that he was getting ₹50,000 per month, out of which ₹25,000 was being spent on different obligations. Therefore, as an interim measure, while directing the petitioner to file his affidavit in terms of the Supreme Court judgment in *Rajnesh v. Neha* 2021(2) SCC 324, the Family Court directed him to pay interim maintenance to the tune of ₹10,000 per month to the

Keeping in view the admitted income of the petitioner, and also the fact that only as an interim measure he has been directed to pay the amount of maintenance, no exception can be taken to the impugned order.

Petition stands dismissed.
