ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN J. (Oral)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 29.11.2022, vide which it was directed that the Executing Court will adjourn the date beyond the date fixed by this Court and to recall the warrants of possession.

Counsel for the petitioners submit that despite the aforementioned order, the proceedings were initiated for taking the warrants of possession.

As per the compliance affidavit filed by the SHO, Police Station Beas, Amritsar (Rural), it is stated that in compliance of the earlier order, the police team was deputed to assist the bailiff to hand over the possession on 29.11.2022 And at about 03:00 PM, the petitioner/judgment-debtor Sucha Singh, produced the order dated 29.11.2022, directing this Court to recall the warrants of possession.

Accordingly, the execution process was stopped and a report was made by the bailiff that the proceedings with regard to execution of warrants of possession were stopped.

In view of the above, it is stated that there is no willful disobedience of the order as and when the order of the High Court was communicated, the proceedings of execution of warrants of possession were stopped.

Accordingly, no further action is called for and the petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
