SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The writ petitioner is aggrieved from the tardiness in the conclusion of the consolidation operations, as are underway in the *mohal* concerned, and, which commenced in the year 2018. Normally, the consolidation proceedings are expected to lawfully conclude, within the shortest period of time, since their commencement, but given the fact that the consolidation operations commenced in the year 2018, and, yet theirs yet becoming not lawfully concluded. Therefore, prima facie, it appears, that the respondents concerned, have delayed the promptest conclusion and termination, in accordance with law, of the consolidation operations, in the *mohal* concerned.

2. However, since the learned State counsel submits, that despite the preparation of the consolidation scheme, yet the same could not be finalized, as certain objections under the relevant statutory provisions, in respect to its finalization, have been raised by the objectors concerned, and, that until a lawful decision is made upon the relevant objections, hence thereupto rather no further progress can be made in respect of lawful termination of the consolidation operations concerned.

3. If so, at this stage, it cannot be said that there is any intentional delay or tardiness on the part of the respondents concerned, to lawfully terminate the consolidation operations, as are underway in the *mohal* concerned.

4. Nonetheless, for ensuring that the consolidation proceedings are promptly besides lawfully terminated, it is deemed fit to make a mandamus upon the respondents concerned, to lawfully terminate the consolidation operations, as underway in the *mohal* concerned, rather imperatively within six months from today.

5. Disposed of.
