The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.131, dated 10.12.2021, under Sections 307/148/149/379/120-B of the IPC, 1860, and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

Mr. Vikas Gupta, Advocate puts in appearance and filed memorandum of appearance on behalf of complainant which is taken on record, though contends that petitioner is not entitled for grant of concession of anticipatory bail against him as allegations under Section 307 are there and recovery of weapon is to be made.

This Court vide order dated 30.01.2023, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners, subject to their joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 30.01.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 30.01.2023 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
