The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of impugned order dated 15.10.2022 passed by the learned JMIC, Sirsa, in the complaint, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was neither served nor any intimation to appear in the Court, process was issued against him and thereafter, proclamation was issued on 15.10.2022.

If a person in a bailable case appears or surrenders in the Court, then he is entitled for bail. Therefore, if petitioner appears or surrenders in the Court, then he is entitled for bail.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 15 days and move an application for bail, the same shall be decided on the same day.
