This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue the sale certificate/conveyance deed in the names of the petitioners as they are the auction purchasers of the land in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after annexing the relevant documents, *prima facie*, showing that some auction had taken place in favour of the petitioners.
