By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays to quash the order dated 30.07.2022 (Annexure P-13), whereby petitioner has been declared proclaimed person in criminal complaint bearing NACT No.784/2018, titled as “*Subhash vs Darbwar*”, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that at the relevant time, petitioner was posted as SPO in Faridabad, Police Station Balabgarh, and presently posted as SPO in District Sirsa, due to which he could not appear despite summoning order. He has been declared proclaimed person. He is ready to surrender. It is further contended that the matter pertains to an amount of ₹88,000/-.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 20.02.2023, Learned Trial Court shall revive the proceedings of the complaint case, if the same has already been consigned and consider the bail petition on the same date. In the meantime, if petitioner is sought to be arrested on account of his having been declared as proclaimed person, he shall be admitted to

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interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

In case, the petitioner fails to make compliance of any of these directions, this order shall be deemed to be vacated.
