LISA GILL J. (ORAL)

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment and decree dated 05.12.2019 passed by Addl. District Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (for short the Act) filed by him has been dismissed.

2. It is informed by learned counsel for the parties that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Petition under Section 13-B of the Act has been filed by them and their statements at first motion have been recorded.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that part of the settlement amount has been paid to the respondent. Petition under Section 13-B of the Act is stated to be listed for recording of statements of the parties at second motion on 31.05.2023.

4. Keeping in view the above, appeal is disposed of as infructuous in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties. Needless to say, the appellant is at liberty to file an appropriate application, in case terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between the parties are not adhered to by the respondent.
