Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of notification dated 29.08.2014 (Annexure P-2), vide which 3rd ACP has been granted on completion of 24 years of regular satisfactory service.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners retired from the post of Sub Divisional Officer (SDO) on different dates depicted in Annexure P-1. He submits that by notification, Annexure P-2, benefit of 3rd Assured Career Progression has been granted, but the petitioners have not been given its benefit. He submits that representation dated 18.10.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted to the respondents, but the same is lying

unattended. He submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to examine the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a return.

Having heard counsel for the parties, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 18.10.2022 (Annexure P-3) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are not found entitled to the claim, an order be passed assigning the reasons for rejection.
