Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.659, dated 26.12.2022, under Section 20(b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section-27A of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind (Haryana).

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Mahabir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation. He further contends that the investigation is almost complete.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 02.02.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 Cr. PC.
