By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.351 dated 30.05.2021 registered under Section 346 IPC (later on Section 302, 201 IPC added) at Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad.

It is revealed that FIR was lodged on the complaint of Ruby, wife of deceased Ravi as per which her husband Ravi had left home on 28.05.2021. She suspected some unknown persons to have confined her husband. Mother of the deceased made a complaint suspecting the role of her daughter-in-law, i.e. Ruby who had illicit relations with one Sandeep, in murder of her son. Sandeep was joined in the investigation who admitted his involvement in the murder of Ravi. It was further disclosed by him that dead body of deceased Ravi was thrown by him in the canal with the help of petitioner- Sachin. Thus, only role attributed to the petitioner is that he with the help of accused Sandeep had thrown the dead body. As per the custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 03 days. The case is dependant upon circumstantial evidence.

Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner, which prima-facie reveals that he has no role to play as far as murder of Ravi is concerned, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
