The learned counsel representing respondent No.1 submits that the revision petition is rendered infructuous as the suit filed by the respondent was dismissed in default on 29.09.2022 and as per the instructions of the respondent through his son, the respondent is not interested in reviving the suit.

2. This revision petition has been filed against the interlocutory orders passed by the trial Court as well as First Appellate Court while deciding application under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for revival, if the suit, which has been dismissed in default, is restored.
