Though the petitioner has stated that this is his first petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.251, dated 12.12.2019 registered under Section 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, however, from the office note, it is evident that this is petitioner's second attempt to get bail in the said FIR.

On 18.09.2020, the petitioner's first petition for grant of bail was dismissed as it was found that the recovery from the petitioner and his co-accused falls in the category of commercial quantity. The petitioner prays for bail in view of the order passed in the case of his co-accused Kuldip Singh @ Kali in CRM-M-20070-2022 titled as '**Kuldip Singh @ Kali vs. State of Punjab**' on 06.01.2023. On reading thereof, it is evident that the co-accused of the petitioner was granted bail in view of the fact that the petitioner's father in that case was suffering from numerous disabilities as both his legs had to be amputated due to gangrene.

Hence, the petitioner cannot claim bail on parity with his co-accused Kuldeep Singh @ Kali. Consequently, finding no fresh ground for bail, the same is hereby declined.

Hence, the petition stands dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
