SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since the Gram Panchayat concerned, has accessed this Court for implementation and enforcement of the order, as made by the Director concerned. However, when this Court, on the asking of the learned counsel for the petitioners, has proceeded to permit him to withdraw the writ petition bearing No.CWP-18211-2022, but with liberty assigned to him to within 2 weeks, thus appeal against the order drawn by the Director concerned.

2. Therefore, since the order sought to be enforced or implemented, as such, has not acquired the completest binding, and, conclusive effect. Consequently, the instant writ petition is also disposed of. However, it is permissible for the writ petitioners in CWP-18211-2022 to cause their impleadment through an appropriate application being filed, thus in the statutory appeal, to be filed, thus before the Competent Appellate Authority concerned, hence at the instance of the petitioners in writ petition No. CWP-18211-2022.
