The present petition is for seeking directions to the respondent that in event of his arrest petitioner be released on bail in FIR No.98 dated 01.12.2022, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even presuming all the allegations leveled in the FIR to be true and the said incident took place in Delhi, and therefore, the said FIR at Ropar could not be lodged.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant and was with regard to the miscarriage of the complainant.

This Court does not find any merit to grant the discretionary concession of anticipatory bail to the husband, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
