1. The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No.106 dated 15.11.2012 under Sections 498-A/406/506 of IPC registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise/judgment dated 13.07.2021 passed in a petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

2. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has been acquitted by learned trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 26.05.2023 and the present petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, he shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
