The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.355 dated 29.11.2020 under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

Vide order dated 06.04.2022, the petitioner had been granted concession of interim bail in view of the affidavit filed by Assistant Inspector General of Police, Litigation Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh in CRM-M-19439-2020 titled “Manpreet Singh @ Kaka vs. State of Punjab”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.04.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel assisted by the learned counsel appearing for the complainant, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 06.04.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
