Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.94 dated 04.12.2012, registered for offences under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, including report under Section 173, Cr.P.C., Annexure P-2, and order dated 18.09.2015, Annexure P-5, passed by JMIC, Kapurthala, whereby petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person.
